### A Resolution Approving an Amended Grant Award Providing Additional Funds from the Arizona Department of Education for the Nation's Johnson-O'Malley Program for FY2022

- WHEREAS: The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council ("Council") is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Nation") and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Constitution") as provided by Article V (a) of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Council, as the legislative body of the Nation, is authorized to enact laws, ordinances, and resolutions incidental to the exercise of its legislative powers as provided by Article V(v) of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Council is authorized to negotiate with other governments, manage the economic affairs of the Nation, appropriate and regulate the use of the Nations funds, and accept grants, all as provided under Article V(b), (i), (k) and (s) respectively of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Nation administers the Johnson-O'Malley Program (JOM) under grants from the State of Arizona Department of Education (AZ-DOE); and
- WHEREAS: As authorized under Tribal Council Resolution No. 71-2021, the Nation applied to AZ-DOE and was awarded grant funds in the amount of \$14,586.80 in support of the Nation's JOM Program (Grant Award); and
- WHEREAS: AZ-DOE has notified the Nation that the Grant Award has been amended to provide the Nation additional funding of \$11,902.93 for use by the Nation's JOM Program during FY2022, thereby increasing the total grant award to \$26,489.73; and
- WHEREAS: The JOM Program Manager has provided the Council with a summary of the amended Grant Award and a budget showing how the additional funds will be expended during FY2022, see **Exhibit A** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and
- WHEREAS: The Council finds it in the Nation's best interest to approve the amended AZ-DOE Grant Award and the budget submitted by the JOM Manager for expenditure of the additional funds during FY2022 as shown in the attached Exhibit A.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby approves the Amended Grant Award from the AZ-DOE, which provides additional funds in support of the Nation's JOM Program in the amount of \$11,902.93, thereby increasing the total Grant Award for FY2022 to \$26,489.73, as set out in **Exhibit A** to this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Council also approves the Budget submitted by the Nation's JOM Manager for the expenditure of the additional funds during FY2022 as set out in **Exhibit A** to this Resolution.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Chairman, and Vice-Chairwoman, or either of them, are hereby authorized to take such further action as deemed necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this Resolution.
