Amanda Honwytewa mentioned they will continue to do fundraising and work on seeking donations from local businesses and vendors. They will be bringing a resolution and budget back to the Council to approve.

Lorna Juan expresses she supports it. She has attended the UNITY Conferences. It is interesting to see 2000 Native American Youth. The conferences are good and uplifting. Both of her kids were in UNITY.

Vice Chairwoman Lewis announced there will be a Pai Gathering held on June 24-25th at Hualapai. There will be no naming ceremony. They will be honoring all of the Pai Women who were lost in the past two years. You are invited to attend. There will also be a zoom option.

Roberta Pavatea reported there is a handicapped elder being harassed by a non-native. It is escalating. She would like the Council to rescind the resolution allowing non-Indians who are head of household live in our homes.

Chairman Huey will meet with Roberta Pavatea after the meeting.

Lorna Juan suggested getting YAPD and Social Services involved. When there are children and Elders involved the departments need to help.

Darlene Rubio motioned to adjourn at 9:43 a.m. seconded by Germania Jones; 9 For, 0 Against, 0 Abstained, motion passed.
