

**RESOLUTION NO. 129 -22
OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION**

**A Resolution Approving Membership for Luis Michael Arvizu and
Maysie River Lowry**

WHEREAS: The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council (“Council”) is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation (“Nation”) and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation (“Constitution”) as provided by Article V(a) of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Council is authorized to implement by Ordinance the membership provisions of the Constitution as provided by Article II, Section 5 of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: Article II Membership, Subsection 1(c) of the Constitution provides that all persons who are one fourth (1/4) or more Yavapai-Apache Indian Blood shall be eligible for membership in the Nation; and

WHEREAS: Membership applications for Luis Michael Arvizu and Maysie River Lowry have been received by the Nation; and

WHEREAS: The Enrollment Board, with input from the Enrollment Manager, has determined that the above referenced applicants satisfy the requirements for membership in the Yavapai-Apache Nation under Article II Membership, Subsection 1(c) of the Constitution and recommends to the Tribal Council that the applicants be approved for membership in the Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai-Apache Nation Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby approves the enrollment of Luis Michael Arvizu and Maysie River Lowry as members of the Yavapai-Apache Nation as provided for under Article II Membership, Subsection 1(c) of the Constitution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman and Vice-Chairwoman, or either of them, are hereby authorized to take such further action as deemed necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this Resolution.

CERTIFICATION
