

RESOLUTION NO. 185-22
OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION

A Resolution Denying Membership for Julian Francisco Rios

WHEREAS: The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council (“Council”) is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation (“Nation”) and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation (“Constitution”) as provided by Article V(a) of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Council is authorized to implement by Ordinance the membership provisions of the Constitution as provided by Article II, Section 5 of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: The eligibility requirements for membership in the Yavapai-Apache Nation are set out in the Constitution, Article II Membership, and the procedures for applying for membership in the Nation are codified in the Yavapai-Apache Nation Tribal Codes, Title I Enrollment Code; and

WHEREAS: The Enrollment Code requires the Tribal Council to approve or deny all applications for membership in accordance with the membership eligibility requirements of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: A membership application for Julian Francisco Rios has been received by the Nation; and

WHEREAS: The Enrollment Board, with input from the Enrollment Manager, has determined that Julian Francisco Rios does not satisfy the requirements for membership in the Yavapai-Apache Nation set out in Article II Membership of the Constitution and recommends to the Tribal Council that the applicant be denied membership in the Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby denies the enrollment of Julian Francisco Rios as a member of the Yavapai-Apache Nation for failure to satisfy the membership eligibility requirements of Article II Membership of the Constitution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Vice Chairwoman is hereby authorized to take such further action as deemed necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this Resolution.

CERTIFICATION

I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by an affirmative vote of the Tribal Council, with a quorum in attendance, presented for approval on September 29 2022, by a vote of 7, 6 in favor, 1 opposed and 0 abstaining, pursuant to the authority contained under the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation as cited above.




