RESOLUTION NO. \38-22 OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION

A Resolution Appointing Gary Donahoe as an Interim Associate Justice of the Yavapai-Apache Nation Court of Appeals

- WHEREAS: The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council ("Council") is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Nation") and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Constitution") as provided under Article V(a) of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Council is authorized to appoint Associate Justices of the Nation's Court of Appeals as provided under Article VI, Sections 5 and 6, respectively, of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Council is currently in the selection process for an Associate Justice position and desires to appoint Gary Donahoe as an Interim Associate Justice to serve as the third Justice on a case pending before the Court of Appeals, and the Council has determined that the appointment of Gary Donahoe as an Interim Associate Justice is in the best interest of the Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby appoints Gary Donahoe as an Interim Associate Justice of the Nation's Court of Appeals to serve as the third Justice on a case pending before the Nation's Court of Appeals.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairwoman and Vice-Chairman, or either of them, are hereby authorized to take such further action as deemed necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this Resolution.
