According to Section 301(b) of the revised Gaming Code, there are certain qualifications:

- (1) Must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older.**
- (2) Must have never been convicted of a felony, criminal drug offense, gaming offense, or any other criminal conduct which would preclude the person from receiving a Tribal Gaming License.**
- (3) Must have no financial interest in, or management responsibility for any Gaming Activity.**
- (4) Must have no financial interest in any business or entity which provides Gaming Services to the Nation, or that is a Distributor or Manufacturer of Gaming Devices for the Nation.**
- (5) Must qualify for and obtain a valid Tribal Gaming License**
- (6) Is not a member of the Tribal Council; and**
- (7) Complies with any policy approved by the Tribal Council restricting the Nation's Board and Commission members from being an immediate family member of Tribal Council member if such a policy is in effect at the time of appointment.**

This Gaming Code was Revised by Resolution 180-16 and was approved by the NIGC on November 21, 2016.
