RESOLUTION NO. _____--22 OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION

A Resolution Authorizing the Nation to Contract with JCH, Inc., for Parts and Repairs to the Nation's Wastewater Lift Station at the Distant Drums RV Resort

- WHEREAS: The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council ("Council") is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Nation") and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Constitution") as provided by Article V(a) of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Council is authorized to "manage all tribal economic affairs and enterprises" and to "appropriate and regulate the use of tribal funds" as provided by Article V (i) and (k), respectively, of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS: The Council is responsible to provide for the health, safety, and general welfare of the Nation and its people; and
- WHEREAS: The Nation's Utility Department Director has advised the Council of the need to purchase parts and repair services required for the safe, effective, and efficient operation of the Nation's wastewater lift station at the Distant Drums RV Resort (DDRV); and
- WHEREAS: The Council recognizes that the safe, effective, and efficient operation of the Nation's wastewater systems is critical to the health and safety of the Nation's citizens, the operation of the Nation's business at DDRV, as well as protection of the natural environment; and
- WHEREAS: The Nation's Utility Department has solicited quotes for the needed parts and repair services and has selected JCH Inc., ("JCH"), to provide the parts and repair services needed to resolve current operational issues at the DDRV lift station. The parts and labor will be provided by JCH in accordance with the terms and conditions of JCH's Report and Quotation #102622 ("Agreement") dated October 26, 2022, copies of which are attached to and incorporated into this Resolution as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS: The Council has determined that procurement of the parts and repair services needed for the safe, effective, and efficient operation of the Nation's DDRV lift station, as set out in the attached Exhibit A, is in the Nation's best interest, and that funding for the cost of said parts and repair services is available in the Utility Department's FY2022 operating budget for maintenance and repairs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai-Apache Nation Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby authorizes the Yavapai-Apache Nation to contract with JCH, Inc., to provide the parts and repair services needed to resolve current operational issues at the Nation's DDRV lift station; all in accordance with the terms and conditions of the JCH's Report and Quotation #102622 ("Agreement") dated October 26, 2022, copies of which are attached to and incorporated into this Resolution as Exhibit A, with compensation paid to JCH under the Agreement Not To Exceed Five Thousand One Hundred Forty-Eight and 26/100 Dollars (\$5,148.26), unless

subsequent Council approval for an increase in compensation is provided as set forth in an amendment to the Agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds for payment to JCH under the Agreement are hereby appropriated and shall be paid from the Utility Department's FY2022 operating budget for maintenance and repairs in the amount of Five Thousand One Hundred Forty-Eight and 26/100 Dollars (\$5,148.26).

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairwoman, and Vice-Chairman, or either of them, are hereby authorized to execute the above referenced Agreement on behalf of the Nation and to take such further action as deemed necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this Resolution.

During the service visit, I inspected the stations, operated the pumps, pulled the pumps, changed oil, checked glycol fluid levels, checked impeller clearance and grinder cutters and verified the electrical controls to be in working order.

I left the controls in the automatic position.

Attached is a copy of the pertinent electrical data that was recorded during our test.

At Distant Drum RV Resort lift station, both pumps require new cutting parts A.S.A.P. These parts are severely worn and need replacement. This is definitely causing the clogging issues and lower GPM. I have attached a quote for the parts prices and install for you to review. These parts are in stock and I can schedule this work upon your approval with a P.O.#.

At the Tunlii lift station, pump #1 was switched out with the spare pump and that pump was brought to our shop for repair.
