

RESOLUTION NO. 212-22
OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION

A Resolution Appointing Gary Donahoe as Associate Justice of the
Yavapai-Apache Nation Court of Appeals

WHEREAS: The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council (“Council”) is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation (“Nation”) and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation (“Constitution”) as provided under Article V(a) of the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Council is authorized to appoint Associate Justices of the Nation’s Court of Appeals for a two-year term as provided under Article VI, Sections 5 and 6, respectively, of the Constitution; and


WHEREAS: The Council has completed the selection process for an Associate Justice position and the Council has selected Gary Donahoe to fill said position for a two-year term as provided under the Constitution, and the Council has determined that the appointment of Gary Donahoe as Associate Justice is in the best interest of the Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby appoints Gary Donahoe as Associate Justice of the Nation’s Court of Appeals for a two-year term commencing when swearing in said position is accomplished.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairwoman and Vice-Chairman, or either of them, are hereby authorized to take such further action as deemed necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this Resolution.

CERTIFICATION
