

**RESOLUTION NO. 157 -23
OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
YAVAPAI-APACHE NATION**

**A Resolution Reappointing Rodolfo Garcia as an Associate Justice of the
Yavapai-Apache Nation Court of Appeals**

- WHEREAS:** The Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council ("Council") is authorized to represent the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Nation") and act on all matters that concern the health and welfare of the Nation, and to make decisions not inconsistent with or contrary to the Constitution of the Yavapai-Apache Nation ("Constitution") as provided under Article V(a) of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS:** The Council is authorized to appoint Associate Justices of the Nation's Court of Appeals for two-year terms as provided under Article VI, Sections 5 and 6, respectively, of the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS:** The Council is authorized to reappoint Associate Justices for additional two-year terms as provided under Article VI, Section 6 and Section 112(f) of the Nation's Judicial Code; and
- WHEREAS:** Associate Justice Rodolfo Garcia has requested reappointment for an additional two-year term as provided under Article VI, Section 6 and Section 112(f) of the Nation's Judicial Code; and
- WHEREAS:** The Council has determined that reappointment of Rodolfo Garcia as an Associate Justice for an additional two-year term commencing September 21, 2023 is in the best interest of the Nation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai-Apache Tribal Council, in Council assembled, at which a quorum is present, hereby reappoints Rodolfo Garcia as an Associate Justice of the Nation's Court of Appeals for a two-year term commencing September 21, 2023.


