

Hlaá nymúcha - "New Moon"

January 2026

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January is the 5th moon in the Yavapai year, often referred to as "Hand cut off" and written as "Hlaa sál láaya". It is interpreted as a constellation of a frog and it represents the frog's left hand. It appears in the East and is translated as "stubborn hand" because the left hand is difficult to a right handed person. During this month the deer are underweight and the road runners are making their whooping calls.
