Vendor Agreement

The Vendor, _____, hereby agrees to the terms and conditions of this Vendor Agreement (“Agreement”) for participation at the Havasupai Tribe’s (“Tribe”) 26th Annual Gathering of the Pai Festival. This Agreement shall begin on June 5, 2026, and expire on midnight of June 6, 2026, unless otherwise stated herein.

I. Responsibilities of Vendor

- A. Registration will be open from 11:00am to 3:00pm on Friday, June 5, 2026, for set up. Vendor must be in its booth(s)/space by 3:00pm on Friday and 9:00am on Saturday, and be ready for business and remain open until the conclusion of the event.
- B. Vendor shall maintain a sanitary and clean booth at all times. Failure to do so shall result in the booth/space being temporary closed until remedied.
- C. Vendor shall be responsible for his/her own supplies, merchandise, tables, chairs, canopy(ies), generators, signage, and any other material. Signage must include Vendor’s name, food/items for sale or promotion, and prices.
- D. All generators must be properly grounded.
- E. Vendor shall be responsible for payment of all taxes, including federal, state, and local taxes, arising out of Vendor’s activities in accordance with this Agreement (including, by way of illustration but not limitation, federal and state income tax, Social Security tax, unemployment insurance taxes, and any other taxes).

II. Responsibilities of the Havasupai Tribe

The Tribe will provide Vendor with the following:

- 1) Space for arts, crafts, and other approved vendors. Should any additional space be needed, Vendor must request additional space in writing.
- 2) Waste dumpsters, which will be located within the vicinity.

III. Fees

No fees will be charged for any Vendor who is a member of one of the following tribes: Fort McDowell Yavapai Nation, Havasupai Tribe, Hualapai Tribe, Yavapai-Apache Nation, Yavapai-Prescott Indian Tribe, and Paipai.

IV. Adherence to Policy

Vendor agrees to abide by the Tribe’s laws and other applicable laws. Vendor further agrees that Vendor’s employees, agents, and representatives shall also abide by such laws. Failure to abide by such laws will result in termination of this Agreement.

V. Indemnification Agreement

Vendor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Tribe, its affiliates, officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages, including attorney’s fees, which may arise in any manner from Vendor’s activities or presence on Tribe’s property and jurisdiction as authorized by this Agreement. This release and indemnification obligation includes, but is not limited to, claims made by Vendor, its agents, and employees. This indemnity shall survive termination or expiration of this Agreement.



VI. Choice of Law and Forum

The laws of the Havasupai Tribe shall govern this Agreement, without regard to conflicts of law principles. The Tribal Court of the Havasupai Tribe shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising from or related to this Agreement.

VII. Severability and Interpretation

If any term of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, then this Agreement, including all of the remaining terms, will remain in full force and effect as if such invalid or unenforceable term had never been included. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement pertaining to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement terminates and supersedes all prior understandings or agreements on the subject matter hereof. This Agreement shall in no way create the relationship of employer and employee, partnership, or joint venture. Vendor agrees to have fully read and understood this Agreement and that the Agreement shall be construed neither against nor in favor of either Vendor or the Tribe but shall be construed in a neutral manner.

VIII. Sovereign Immunity

Nothing contained herein, or in any related or referenced document, shall be construed to constitute a waiver of any aspect or portion of sovereign immunity of the Nation, and/or its affiliates, agents, committees, departments, programs, enterprises, or subdivisions.
